We invite you to apply to be a vendor at the Great Ocmulgee RiverFest on July 16, 2005. All vendors will set up at the Pulaski County Boat Landing on Highway 129. Registration begins at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 10:00 a.m. The fee is \$25 per vendor, regardless of space needed. In conjunction with the festivities at Pulaski County Boat Landing, there will be a river excursion for canoes, kayaks, and tubes, a homemade raft race and a rubber duck race all ending at the landing during the course of the day. Festivities will conclude after the last vessel reaches the landing and the duck race is complete, probably late afternoon. This is a first time event, but we expect at least 500 people to attend. There is no admission fee for onlookers.

The enclosed registration form and entry fee(\$25) should be returned to the Chamber of Commerce no later than Friday, July 8. *A maximum of 3 food vendors selling different items will be accepted on a first come first served basis.* Also enclosed is a map of Hawkinsville and listings of local hotels and eateries.
